



Approving Activities in Beverley and Hornsea

Last Reviewed: 1st April 2025

POR (rule 9.1.2.1) states that “The District Lead Volunteer is responsible for approving all activities for Squirrels, Beavers, Cubs, Scouts, Explorers and Scout Network. This must be by means of a system agreed between the District Lead Volunteer and each Group Lead Volunteer or District 14-25 Team Leader.”

This document shows the process and the delegated responsibilities for authorising activities under POR Rule 9.1.2.1 in Beverley and Hornsea District.

1. The District Lead Volunteer is responsible for authorising all activities that take place in Beaver, Cub and Scout sections in their Group (with the exception of those mentioned elsewhere in this document).
2. The District 14 – 24 Team Leader is responsible for authorising all activities that take place in Explorer Scout Units in the District (with the exception of those mentioned elsewhere in this document).
3. All visits abroad need to follow the appropriate process as set out on POR rule 9.3 and any other appropriate rules as set out in POR. (last reviewed April 2025)
4. All Nights Away Notification (NAN) forms for Nights Away activities must be submitted electronically My Membership on scouts.org.uk along with copies of relevant documents. The District Lead Volunteer (or nominee) will then give positive approval or give other feedback, the event must not take place without positive approval from the District Lead Volunteer (or nominee).

5. Where an activity is covered within the Adventurous Activity Permit Scheme and led by a member of the District holding the relevant permit, the DLV & GLV / 14 – 24 TL must be aware of the activity taking place on each occasion (see points 1 and 2). If you are using someone from outside the District with a permit the DLV & GLV / 14 – 24 TL must also be informed.
6. All Air Activities need to follow the appropriate process as set out on POR rule 9.10 and any other appropriate rules as set out in POR. (last reviewed April 2025)
7. All activities must also follow all the rules set out in POR chapter 9, and all other relevant chapters and rules of POR.
